Subject: - Grant of Yearly Permission to Bhargava Ayurveda College, Vidyagram, R H Patel Education Campus, Dahemi, Ta. Borsad, Distt. Anand-388560, Gujarat (Inst. ID-AYU0441) with intake capacity 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and 2nd Renewal of Permission for seat increase from 60 seats to 100 seats, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26 -reg.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Bhargava Ayurveda College, Vidyagram, R H Patel Education Campus, Dahemi, Ta. Borsad, Distt. Anand-388560, Gujarat (Inst. ID-AYU0441)** inspection was conducted on **08.04.2025 and 09.04.2025 in hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the **permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and 2nd Renewal of Permission for seat increase from 60 seats to 100 seats, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.**
- 2) The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. **On careful examination of the assessment report shortcomings/defects were observed and same was communicated to you vide letter of even no. 05.07.2025.** In response on the same you have submitted the clarification **vide an email dated 07.07.2025.**
- 3) Accordingly, the submitted clarification and the assessment report was once again carefully examined in terms of concerned Acts & Regulations and provision under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations **thereunder, and after verification observation is as under:-**

1. Teaching staffs:-

- a) **Availability of total teaching staff for UG (BAMS) Course as per the part 1 submitted by the college is**

The faculty was present on the day of visitation and working with all valid documents which were shown to the Visiting Authorities of NCISM and her documents were also forwarded to NCISM to be considered and counted as a Faculty of Bhargava Ayurveda College. The further clarification of lacuna of Prasuti tantra & strirog Professor has been mentioned in point no. 3

2) Shortcomings Table, row no. 5 shows Prasuti & Strirog Department lacuna of 1 Higher faculty with "0" Professor in the department. The clarification for this lacuna is as below -

A. The Faculty, **Dr. Bhargavi Parmar joined the Bhargava Ayurveda College on 14th Feb 2025** date as **Associate Professor**. Her appointment letter is attached with this letter.

B. The details of the faculty joining related activities are as follows -

Date of Promotion as Professor: - 15th Feb 2025

Date of application for Revoking the Teacher Code of Dr. Bhargavi Parmar - 15th Feb 2025

The same is then under the ownership of TO after approval from AR

After receiving approval from AR, Institute immediately applied for the linking of faculty which was pending till the date of visitation. Date of Final Approval and linking with Bhargava Ayurveda College: - 11th April 2025

C. The above-mentioned ongoing process was stuck in technical errors and hence the Institute haven't submitted the part 1 till 4th March 2025 due to in process joining procedure of Dr. Bhargavi Parmar for which the part 1 was frizzed by NCISM.

D. As per the Telephonic Conversation with TO no. 74 on the date 26th March 2025 the part 1 was defrizzed for the submission, the Institute submitted the part 1 in spite of non-linking of Dr. Bhargavi Parmar due to technical issues as per the recommendations of TO no 74 we have submitted PART-I with a condition that Dr. Bhargavi Parmar to be considered as Professor faculty

The communication with NCISM was done for several times regarding Dr. Bhargavi Parmar joining and approval process as Professor, Pasuti & Strirog which is attached with this Letter.</p> <p>F. Dr. Bhargavi Parmar was present during the day of Visitation and her above said documents were verified by the Visiting Authorities of NCISM and were requested to forward the same for her consideration by NCISM and they were in agreement to consider her as professor in Prasuti tantra and strirog.</p> <p>G. The approval of linking of Dr. Bhargavi Parmar as faculty in Prasuti tantra and Strirog department of Bhargava Ayurveda College was received on 11th April 2025 after inspection that is 8th and 9th April 2025.</p> <p>As per the communication and records, the faculty was in process of linking. Due to technical errors faculty was not linked in NCISM portal but she was working as full-time faculty since the joining date. Hence, we request you that, Dr. Bhargavi Parmar to be considered as the Professor I.e. Higher Faculty of Prasuti tantra and Strirog Department on the day of Visitation.</p> <p>After considering the Professor I.e. - 4) The submission made by the college during clarification and assessment report have been carefully examined in terms of the concerned Acts & Regulations and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and as per the direction of the competent authority the assessment report along with clarification report was placed in the **133th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **11.07.2025** and Board concluded that the college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations but fulfilling the criteria in accordance with the Board's policy letter issued on 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025. Hence, the Board decided to issue yearly permission with intake capacity of intake capacity 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and 2nd Renewal of Permission for seat increase from 60 seats to 100 seats, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.

"DECISION"

- 5) Therefore, Yearly Permission is hereby granted to Bhargava Ayurveda College, Vidyagram, R H Patel Education Campus, Dahemi, Ta. Borsad, Distt. Anand-388560, Gujarat (Inst. ID-AYU0441) in accordance with Regulation 54 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 and as per the Policy letter dated 09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025 with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and 2nd Renewal of Permission for seat increase from 60 seats to 100 seats for the academic session 2025-26, under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that aforementioned shortcomings shall be fulfilled along with the following conditions:-

- I. Minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
- II. Determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 6) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 7) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 8) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 9) Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.
- 10) **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
- i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
- ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
- iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
- iv) The remaining shortcomings mentioned in Para no. 3 above, shall be fulfilled.
- 11) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
